

Literacy Lestur til árangurs

Hólabrekkuskóli works according to the school's literacy policy Reading for Success, which emphasizes targeted literacy work throughout schooling. Part of the project is to provide students with regular literacy screenings and to come up with an intervention based on evidence-based methods that are known to be effective.

Mentor and school attendance Mentor og skólasókn

Lessons start at 08:30 for all students in 1-7th grade. Students in 8-10th grade take the bus at 08:50. Illness and leave must be reported in teleph. 411-7550 or on mentor.is. If a student is sick for several days, the school must be informed daily.

Mentor is the school's web system and enables parents and students to access various information from the school, such as homework, timetable, practice, assessment, class list, etc. Parents receive a password from the school office by email. The school's secretary provides all information regarding Mentor in s. 411-7550. The URL is: http://www.mentor.is

Students receive a grade for school attendance that is valid for the entire school year. All students start with a score of 10 and the school attendance score is recorded on the report card and Mentor. The school sends weekly information to parents via e-mail about the status of school attendance.



Phonefree school Símalaus skóli

Students are phone-free during school hours, from opening to closing. A phone-free school encourages increased communication between students and teachers as well as between students. If the telephone rule is not followed, the student returns the telephone to the school office where the parent attends. If not, a response to a violation of school rules is followed.






School lunch Mötuneyti og nesti

Students have the option of buying a hot meal for lunch every day of the week. The food is paid for afterwards, in installments, one month at a time. More information can be obtained from the office and on the school's website. The menu for the month appears on the school's website.

Oatmeal is offered by the school every morning from 8:15 - 8:30.

Students bring a healthy and tasty lunch to school and water in a bottle. Holabrekkól is a nut-free school. This means that food inside the school does not contain nuts of any kind, neither peanuts nor tree nuts (pecans, cashews, almonds, etc.).







Recess - Friminutur

Students in grades 1-7 go out for recess and therefore need to be dressed according to the weather. Students in 8th - 10th grade may stay inside during breaks.

Buddy team - Vinaliðar

During breaks, students take turns being friends, leading various games and inviting other students to join. The aim of this project is to offer positive entertainment on the school grounds during recess. Students who take on the role of the buddy team receive excellent leadership training through the role.
